GET Method

- ▶ **GET method will pass the values via URL**

POST Method

- ▶ **POST method will pass the values via HTTP request**



POST Method

- ▶ **POST method will pass the values via HTTP request**
- ▶ **Passed values will not be seen in the URL**



POST Method

- ▶ **POST method will pass the values via HTTP request**
- ▶ **Passed values will not be seen in the URL**
- ▶ **It is advisable to use POST method for secure transactions like login and money transactions**



Form Methods

Syntax:

- ▶ GET: `<form action="form2.html" method="get">`
- ▶ POST: `<form action="form2.html" method="post">`
- ▶ action attribute **defines the place to which the values have to be passed**
