- ▶ Variables are **local** to their own Shell



export command

- ▶ Variables are **local** to their own Shell
- ▶ **Local variables** can be used by same Shell or by the current Shell



export command



export command

- ▶ Exports a variable or a function to the environment of all child processes



export command

- ▶ Exports a variable or a function to the environment of all child processes
- ▶ Can also change a local variable to a global variable
