

### Instruction Sheet for GIMP Installation Spoken Tutorial Team IIT Bombay



## 1 The procedure to install GIMP on Ubuntu Linux OS

- 1. To follow the installation procedure, you need to be connected to the internet.
- 2. You must have Synaptic Package Manager installed on your machine.
- 3. If not installed, please install Synaptic Package Manager using Ubuntu Software Center.

#### 1.1 The procedure to install GIMP

- 1. On Ubuntu 11.04 and higher,
  - (a) Press the Window key on your key-board to open Dash Home.
  - (b) Type Synaptic Package Manager.
  - (c) Click on the Synaptic Package Manager option.
- 2. Enter your password.
- 3. Click on OK.
- 4. In the search box type GIMP.
- Click on the GIMP check box and click on Mark for Installation.
- 6. Click on Mark.
- 7. Finally, click on Apply.
- 8. Again, click Apply for installation.
- 9. The installation will take a few minutes depending on your internet speed.

## 1.2 The procedure to install GIMP via Terminal

Open the terminal by pressing Ctrl + Alt
+ T keys together.

- 2. Now in the terminal type sudo apt-get install gimp and press Enter.
- 3. Enter the system password if required.
- 4. It will display how much has to be downloaded from the internet and how much disk space will be occupied.
- 5. Type y and press Enter to confirm this.
- 6. This will install GIMP.

### 1.3 The procedure to check GIMP installation

- 1. Open the terminal.
- 2. Now in the terminal type gimp and hit Enter.
- 3. This will open the GIMP interface.

# 2 The procedure to install GIMP on Windows OS

- 1. Go to the website http://www.gimp.org/downloads/.
- 2. Go to the section GIMP for Windows and download the latest GIMP version.no Installer.
- 3. Double-click the downloaded file to run it.
- 4. Follow all the instructions to install GIMP.
- 5. Once the installation is completed successfully, you can open GIMP.
- 6. To open GIMP, click on Start menu, click on All programs and then on GIMP.
